1. Introduction

Niber Technologies Pte. Ltd. ("Niber Technologies," "we," "our," or "us") is committed to protecting the privacy and personal data of all individuals who interact with our business. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard personal data in connection with our website and business operations.

Niber Technologies is a performance materials company headquartered in Singapore, with operations in the Philippines, and sales offices in Hong Kong and the United States. We serve customers globally, and this policy reflects our commitment to meeting applicable privacy standards across all jurisdictions in which we operate.

2. Scope

This Privacy Policy applies to:

- Visitors to our website at <https://niber.tech> (and any subdomains)
- Business contacts, customers, and prospective customers
- Suppliers, distributors, and partners
- Individuals who communicate with us by email, contact forms, or other channels

This policy does not apply to our employees or job applicants, who are covered by separate internal policies.

4. Data Protection Officer

We may collect the following categories of personal data:

- **Contact & Identity Data** Name, job title, company name, business email address, phone number, and mailing address.
- **Inquiry & Communication Data** Messages, inquiries, and correspondence submitted through our website contact forms or sent directly to us.
- **Usage & Technical Data** IP address, browser type and version, operating system, referring URLs, pages visited, time spent on pages, and other standard web analytics data collected via cookies and similar technologies.
- **Transaction & Commercial Data** Purchase history, sample requests, contract details, and related B2B transaction records.
- **Event & Engagement Data** Information provided when registering for events, webinars, or trade show activities we participate in.

We do not knowingly collect sensitive personal data such as health data, financial account credentials, or national ID numbers through this website.

6. How We Collect Personal Data

- Directly from you, when you fill out a contact form, request information, or communicate with us
- Automatically, through cookies and web analytics tools when you visit our site
- From third parties, such as trade event organizers, industry directories, or business partners who refer contacts to us
- From publicly available sources, including LinkedIn and business registries, for B2B prospecting purposes

7. Legal Bases for Processing

Depending on your jurisdiction, we rely on the following legal bases:

Basis	Examples
Legitimate interests (except where such interests are overridden by fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject)	Responding to B2B inquiries, website analytics, fraud prevention, relationship management
Contract performance	Processing orders, fulfilling sample requests, managing supplier relationships
Consent	Marketing communications where consent is required by law
Legal obligation	Retaining records required by applicable law

Where we rely on consent, you have the right to withdraw it at any time without affecting the lawfulness of prior processing.

8. How We Use Personal Data

We use collected personal data to:

- Respond to your inquiries and provide information about our products and materials
- Manage and fulfil B2B commercial relationships
- Send marketing communications about our products, partnerships, and industry developments where permitted
- Improve our website and user experience
- Conduct analytics and measure the effectiveness of our communications
- Comply with applicable legal and regulatory obligations
- Prevent fraud and ensure website security

We do not sell personal data to third parties. We do not use personal data for automated individual decision-making or profiling that produces legal or similarly significant effects.

9. Data Sharing and Disclosure

We may share personal data with:

- **Service Providers & Processors** Third-party vendors who provide services on our behalf, including website hosting, email platforms, CRM software, analytics tools, and IT support. These parties are contractually bound to process data only on our instructions and in accordance with this policy.
- **Business Partners** In limited circumstances, with distributors or commercial partners where necessary to fulfill a business inquiry or transaction, subject to appropriate agreements.
- **Group Companies** Affiliated entities within the Niber Technologies group, including our Philippines operations and US and Hong Kong sales offices, for internal business coordination purposes.
- **Legal & Regulatory Authorities** Where required to comply with applicable law, court orders, or regulatory requirements in any jurisdiction where we operate.
- **Corporate Transactions** In the event of a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, personal data may be transferred as part of that transaction, subject to standard confidentiality protections.

10. International Data Transfers

Niber Technologies operates globally. Your personal data may be transferred to and processed in Singapore, the Philippines, Hong Kong, the United States, and other countries where our service providers operate.

Where such transfers occur, we rely on one or more of the following lawful bases: contractual necessity where the transfer is required to perform or prepare a contract with you; legitimate interests in maintaining and responding to business relationships; and consent where explicitly provided. We remain accountable for transferred data and impose appropriate contractual safeguards on recipients.

11. Jurisdiction-Specific Disclosures

Philippines (Data Privacy Act)

As a company with operations in the Philippines, we comply with the requirements of the National Privacy Commission under Republic Act No. 10173 (Data Privacy Act of 2012). Individuals in the Philippines have the rights of data subjects under Chapter IV of RA 10173, namely: the right to be informed; the right to object; the right to access; the right to rectification (i.e., correct inaccurate data); the right to erasure or blocking; the right to damages for violations; the right to data portability; and the right to lodge a complaint with the National Privacy Commission. Where personal data is compromised in a manner giving rise to a real risk of serious harm, we will notify the National Privacy Commission and affected data subjects within seventy-two (72) hours of knowledge of the breach, in accordance with Section 20(f) of RA 10173 and NPC Circular No. 16-03.

Singapore (PDPA)

Processing of personal data is conducted in compliance with Singapore's Personal Data Protection Act 2012 (PDPA). Individuals in Singapore have rights to access, correct, and withdraw consent for the use of their personal data, subject to legal exceptions.

European Economic Area and United Kingdom

Where processing falls within the scope of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) or UK GDPR, individuals have the rights described in Section 11. Our legal bases for processing are set out in Section 6. Personal data transferred outside the EEA or UK may not be subject to the same level of protection as in your home jurisdiction. Such transfers are conducted on the lawful bases described in Section 9.

United States

Our US sales office operates in compliance with applicable federal and state privacy laws. California residents have rights under the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) and California Privacy Rights Act (CPRA), including the right to know, correct, delete, and opt out of the sale of personal data. We do not sell personal data.

Hong Kong (PDPO)

Processing involving Hong Kong-based individuals is conducted in compliance with the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 615).

12. Your Rights

Depending on your location and applicable law, you may have the right to:

- Access the personal data we hold about you

- Correct inaccurate or incomplete data
- Erase personal data under certain circumstances
- Restrict or object to certain processing activities
- Request data portability where technically feasible
- Withdraw consent at any time where processing is consent-based
- Lodge a complaint with the relevant supervisory authority in your jurisdiction

To exercise any of these rights, please contact us using the details in Section 14. We will respond within the timeframe required by applicable law. We will not discriminate against you for exercising your privacy rights.

13. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

Our website uses cookies and similar technologies for the following purposes:

- **Strictly necessary:** Session management and security
- **Analytics:** Understanding how visitors use our site
- **Marketing and preferences:** Remembering your settings and, where consented, serving relevant content

14. Data Retention

We retain personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected, or as required by applicable law.

- **Inquiry and contact data:** Up to 3 years from last interaction, unless a commercial relationship develops
- **Commercial transaction data:** Up to 7 years, or as required by applicable tax and commercial law
- **Website analytics data:** As configured per our analytics provider's settings, typically 26 months
- **Consent records:** Retained for the duration of the consent and up to 3 years thereafter

When data is no longer required, it is securely deleted or anonymized.
